Household Carbage Cuidebook

A request to all residents of Koshu City

We ask for your cooperation to reduce and sort garbage.

Koshu City is working to make effective use of resources through the "3Rs" of "Reduce," "Reuse," and "Recycle."

Reduce

Let's reduce our waste.

Decrease the amount of cooking scraps by using creative cooking methods and by draining food scraps to reduce weight.

Use up the daily necessities to end, and try to use refillable products.

Recycle

Let's recycle resources.

Recycle what can be recycled by turning it over to resource recovery.

Try to purchase products made from recycled paper, plastic bottles, etc.

Reuse

Let's use things over and over again.

Choose products that can be returned or reused.

If something is no longer needed, give it to someone else or take it to a flea market.

This is Koshu City's guidebook on how to sort and dispose of garbage. In this booklet, you will find information on how to sort and dispose of burnable garbage, non-burnable garbage, recyclables, four items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law, and other types of waste materials.

Use this guidebook to follow the garbage disposal rules.











Collection district and garbage collection day (Enzan district)

Garbage will be collected even on national holidays, except during the year-end and New Year's holidays. Time: between 6:00 am and 8:00 am on collection day.

We collect used cooking oil (used tempura oil)!

- * Collection points: Koshu City Hall, Koshu Citizens' Cultural Center, Katsunuma Health and Welfare Center, Katsunuma Branch Office, Yamato Branch Office.
- * Items collected: General household vegetable oils (rapeseed, soybean, corn, safflower, sunflower, cottonseed, and sesame).

Mineral oil, beef/pork oil (lard), palm oil, etc. will not be collected.

Please put the used cooking oil in a PET bottle when bringing it in for collection.

Caution!

- Please be careful not to mix with water.
- Please remove any impurities such as food crumbs (tenkasu).

Burnable Garbage Bags

- Please use the city's designated garbage bags (yellow).
- It is the responsibility of the person who puts out the garbage to write the name of district/group on the designated burnable garbage bag.

- Please place the garbage in a transparent or semi-transparent bag so the content is visible.
- It is the responsibility of the person who puts out the garbage to write the name of district/group on the non-burnable garbage bag.

TYPES OF GENERAL GARBAGE AND HOW TO DISPOSE OF THEM (1)

Please dispose of general garbage at the garbage station in your district between 6:00 am and 8:00 am.

Garbage stations consist of both burnable and non-burnable stations.

Please dispose of burnable garbage in the designated garbage bags (yellow), and non-burnable garbage in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.


*Never put non-burnable garbage with burnable garbage.




Cut up large items before disposal.

Cut into pieces of about 50 cm before disposal.


Leather Goods



Remove metal parts before disposal.


Plastics

Vinyl Sheeting



Agricultural vinyl sheeting should be taken to agricultural cooperative.

Tempura oil should be soaked up with newspaper or rags, or solidified with a coagulant before disposal as burnable

Flush the fecal matter down the toilet before disposal.

TYPES OF GENERAL GARBAGE AND HOW TO DISPOSE OF THEM (2)



Non-Burnable Garbage



Never put burnable garbage with non-burnable garbage.

Please dispose of non-burnables in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.



Hardware, etc.



Cover the tips of blades with newspaper to avoid injury, and dispose of them in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.



How to dispose of lighters (non-burnable metals)

Use up the fuel completely, put them in a transparent or semi-transparent bag, and dispose of them on non-burnable garbage (hardware) day.



Separate from other hardware and dispose of them in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.



Dry-Cell Batteries



Glass, Ceramics and etc.



Cover broken, sharp parts with newspaper to avoid injury, and dispose of them in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.



How to dispose of spray cans (non-burnable metals)

Always use up the contents of spray cans completely, and dispose of them on non-burnable garbage (hardware) day.



Ceramics, etc.

Cover broken, sharp pieces with newspaper to avoid injury, and dispose of them in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.



How to dispose of thermometers containing mercury (non-burnable glass)

Thermometers etc. containing mercury should be disposed of on glass day in their own bag, separate from other non-burnable glass items.



About Rechargeable Batteries

To dispose of rechargeable batteries (secondary batteries), please use the collection boxes installed at electric appliance stores.

TYPES OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS AND HOW TO DISPOSE OF THEM (1)




Mixed paper and other plastics should be placed at the designated garbage stations in each district between 6:00 am and 8:00 am on collection day.

Mixed paper and white trays are collected at recycling stations.

★ Materials will be collected even on national holidays, except during the year-end and New Year's holidays.



Mixed Paper





Soiled paper (paper diapers, sanitary napkins, tissue paper, oil blotting paper, etc.) cannot be disposed of as mixed paper. Please dispose of them as burnable garbage.

- Place the items in a paper bag, paper box, etc., when disposing of them so that the contents do not spill out or
 make a mess.
- Be sure to erase or scratch out with a pen any personal information before disposal.
- Paper items that can be disposed of without removing parts

Calendars, notebooks, etc. that have metal or plastic parts Envelopes with vinyl windows/papers with paint or ink

Brochures, envelopes, postcards, paper cups, business cards, photographs, empty boxes, calendars, notebooks, planners, copy papers, receipts, wrapping papers, empty cigarette boxes, beverage paper cartons, etc.



Other Plastics



All plastic containers and packaging with this symbol are eligible.Dirty items should be cleaned by rinsing with water before disposal.

Place in a transparent or semi-transparent bag so the contents are visible.
 Please write the name of your district/group on the bag, and write "plastic" on it.





Even if the products are made of plastic, they are not eligible if they are not for packaging or container. Please dispose of them as burnable garbage



Medical and business wastes (syringes, packaging materials, etc.),hazardous and flammable materials (gas lighters, spray cans, knives, shaving razors, etc.) must not be disposed of under this category.





These items can be put out together without sorting. Dispose of heavily soiled items as burnable garbage.

Plastic Containers	Containers for eggs, ready-made food, sweets, curry roux, margarine, miso, tofu, strawberries, etc.
Plastic Films	Packaging films used as wrapping for caramel, tobacco, notebooks, 3-pack yogurt, natto, cup noodles, meat, vegetables, fish, etc.
Bags	Plastic bags for toilet papers, candies, instant noodles, etc., and other plastic bags
Styrofoam	Containers and trays for instant food, cup noodles, meat, vegetables, fish, etc.
Bottles	Bottles for cooking oil, sauces, shampoo, rinse, liquid wax, washer fluid, etc.
Cups	Cups for pudding, yogurt, ice cream, instant foods, etc.
Tubes	Tubes for ketchup, mayonnaise, wasabi, toothpaste, craft glue, etc. (wash the inside of container thoroughly before disposal)
Caps, Lids, Wrappers, etc.	Tube caps, plastic bottle lids and labels, bath salts and detergent lids, etc.
Plastic Shopping Bags	Supermarket bags, etc.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF THE 4 ITEMS SUBJECT TO THE HOME APPLIANCE RECYCLING LAW



Air conditioners, televisions, refrigerators/freezers, and washing machines/dryers must be recycled according to the Home Appliance Recycling Law.

1. Ask the retail store

Ask the store where you are newly purchasing the product or the store where you have purchased the product in the past for collection. You can also request disposal even if you do not purchase from the store.

You must pay the recycling fee and handling fee to the store. For details on how to pay the fee and how to have the items picked up, please contact the home appliance store.

2-1. Ask the collection/transportation company

Ask a collection/transportation company authorized by Koshu City. In addition to the recycling fee, a collection/transportation fee will be charged. Please contact the company for exact price.

2-2. Request for collection at a non-burnable oversized garbage collection point

Such items can be taken to a non-burnable oversized garbage collection point. After paying the recycling fee and the collection/transportation fee, the collection/transportation company will transport the items to the designated collection point.

3. Transport them yourself

If you are able to transport the items yourself, please pay the recycling fee and transfer fee at the post office. You will receive a recycling ticket. Bring the ticket along with the items to be disposed of directly to the designated collection point (there are two locations around Koshu City).
